Big Idea: The very things that threaten to be over our heads are under His feet ... so don't be

afraid. Text: John 6:16-21 I. _____ THEY WERE. When evening came, his disciples went down to the lake, where they got into a boat and set off across the lake for Capernaum. By now it was dark, and Jesus had not yet joined them. A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough. When they had rowed three or three and a half miles, they saw Jesus approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were terrified. But he said to them, "It is I; don't be afraid." Then they were willing to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading. - John 6:16-21 II. _____ THEY WERE THERE. A. Jesus storms. "He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous." - Matthew 5:45b B. Jesus sometimes ______ storms. Deep calls to deep in the roar of your waterfalls; all your waves and breakers have swept over me. - Psalm 42:7 My tears have been my food day and night, while men say to me all day long, "Where is your God?" - Psalm 42:3 Why are you downcast, O my soul? Why so disturbed within me? - Psalm 42:5a For I am the LORD your God, who churns up the sea so that its waves roar. - Isaiah 51:15a You snatch me up and drive me before the wind; you toss me about in the storm. - Job 30:22 Then the LORD spoke to Job out of the storm. - Job 40:6

(C. Jesus in storms.
III.	THEY SAW.
	When they had rowed three or three and a half miles, they saw Jesus approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were terrified. – John 6:19
	But he said to them, "It is I; don't be afraid." – John 6:20
	For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet. The last enemy to be destroyed is death. For he "has put everything under his feet." – 1 Corinthians 15:25-27a
	And God placed all things under his feet – Ephesians 1:22a
IV.	THEY DID.
	But Jesus immediately said to them: "Take courage! It is I. Don't be afraid." "Lord, if it's you," Peter replied, "tell me to come to you on the water." – Matthew 14:27-28
	"Come," he said. – Matthew 14:29a
	Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came toward Jesus. – Matthew 14:29b
	But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" – Matthew 14:30
	Immediately Jesus reached out his hand and caught him. "You of little faith," he said, "why did you doubt?" – Matthew 14:31
	Then he climbed into the boat with them, and the wind died down. They were completely amazed, for they had not understood about the loaves; their hearts were hardened. – Mark 6:51-52
