 - Develop a deeper appreciation for creation.
 - Look with healthy skepticism at all "buy now, pay later" schemes.
 - Obey Jesus' instructions about plain, honest speech.
 - Reject anything that breeds the oppression of others.
 - Shun anything that distracts you from seeking first the kingdom of God.
