Big Idea: It is only when we delight in God's approval and satisfaction more than our spouse's that we are really free to relate to our spouse in the most emotionally healthy fashion. Text: Genesis 29 Now Laban had two daughters; the name of the older was Leah, and the name of the younger was Rachel. - Genesis 29:16 Leah had weak eyes, but Rachel was lovely in form, and beautiful. - Genesis 29:17 Jacob was in love with Rachel and said, "I'll work for you seven years in return for your younger daughter Rachel." - Genesis 29:18 So Jacob served seven years to get Rachel, but they seemed like only a few days to him because of his love for her. - Genesis 29:20 Then Jacob said to Laban, "Give me my wife. My time is completed, and I want to lie with her." - Genesis 29:21 So Laban brought together all the people of the place and gave a feast. But when evening came, he took his daughter Leah and gave her to Jacob, and Jacob lay with her. - Genesis 29:22-23 When morning came, there was Leah! – Genesis 29:25a So Jacob said to Laban, "What is this you have done to me? I served you for Rachel, didn't I? Why have you deceived me?" - Genesis 29:25b

Leah became pregnant and gave birth to a son. She named him Reuben, for she said, "It is because the LORD has seen my misery. Surely my husband will love me now." – Genesis 29:32
