Then Jesus asked, "What is the kingdom of God like? What shall I compare it to? It is like a mustard seed, which a man took and planted in his garden. It grew and became a tree, and the birds of the air perched in its branches." – Luke 13:18-19

Again he asked, "What shall I compare the kingdom of God to? It is like yeast that a woman took and mixed into a large amount of flour until it worked all through the dough." – Luke 13:20-21

Someone asked him, "Lord, are only a few people going to be saved?" – Luke 13:23a

He said to them, "Make every effort to enter through the narrow door, because many, I tell you, will try to enter and will not be able to." – Luke 13:23b-24

"Once the owner of the house gets up and closes the door, you will stand outside knocking and pleading, 'Sir, open the door for us.' But he will answer, 'I don't know you or where you come from.'" – Luke 13:25

"Then you will say, 'We ate and drank with you, and you taught in our streets.' But he will reply, 'I don't know you or where you come from. Away from me, all you evildoers!'" – Luke 13:26-27

"There will be weeping there, and gnashing of teeth." – Luke 13:28a
