Big Idea: Jesus can transform a person from living in spiritual darkness to the light of life.

Text: Luke 18:35-43

I. HIS _____.

As Jesus approached Jericho, a blind man was sitting by the roadside begging. – Luke 18:35

And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, in whose case the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God. – 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 {NASV}

The light shines in the darkness, but the darkness has not understood it. – John 1:5

The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them, because they are spiritually discerned. – 1 Corinthians 2:14

II. HIS _____.

When he heard the crowd going by, he asked what was happening. They told him, “Jesus of Nazareth is passing by.” – Luke 18:36-37

He called out, “Jesus, Son of David, have mercy on me!” – Luke 18:38

Those who led the way rebuked him and told him to be quiet, but he shouted all the more, “Son of David, have mercy on me!” – Luke 18:39

Jesus stopped and ordered the man to be brought to him. When he came near, Jesus asked him, “What do you want me to do for you?” “Lord, I want to see,” he replied. – Luke 18:40-41

III. HIS _____.

Jesus said to him, "Receive your sight; your faith has healed you." Immediately he received his sight and followed Jesus, praising God. When all the people saw it, they also praised God.
