1. The Parable of the Unmerciful Servant

- A. Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times? -Matthew 18:21

- B. Jesus answered, “I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.” -Matthew 18:22

- C. You wicked servant, he said, I cancelled all that debt of yours because you begged me to. Shouldn’t you have had mercy on your fellow servant just as I had on you? -Matthew 18:31

2. Do not receive God’s grace in vain

- A. As God’s co-workers we urge you do not receive God’s grace in vain.
-2 Corinthians 6:1

- B. What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning so that grace may increase?
-Romans 6:1

3. The Parables of the Hidden Treasure and the Pearl

- A. The kingdom of heaven is like treasure hidden in a field. When a man found it, he hid it again, and then in his joy went and sold all he had and bought that field.
