Text: 1 Corinthians 3:10-15, and other selected texts that speak to the issue of rewards

Big Idea: The knowledge that each of us will give an account of himself or herself to God means that every moment matters.

Jeremiah 17:10, "I the Lord search the heart and examine the mind, to **reward** a man according to his conduct, according to what his deeds deserve."

Psalm 62:11-12, "One thing God has spoken, two things have I heard: that you, O God, are strong, ¹² and that you, O Lord, are loving. Surely you will **reward each person** according to what he has done."

Proverbs 24:11-12, "Rescue those being led away to death; hold back those staggering toward slaughter. ¹²If you say, "But we knew nothing about this," does not he who weighs the heart perceive it? Does not he who guards your life know it? Will he not **repay each person** according to what he has done?"

1 Corinthians 3:10-15, "By the grace God has given me, I laid a foundation as an expert builder, and someone else is building on it. But each one should be careful how he builds. ¹¹ For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ. ¹² If any man builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, ¹³ his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work. ¹⁴ If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward. ¹⁵ If it is burned up, he will suffer loss; he himself will be saved, but only as one escaping through the flames."

1. Let's build on the right foundation; because only one is solid.

1 Corinthians 3:11, "For no one can lay any foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ."

John 14:6b, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

2. Let's build with quality; because quality determines durability.

Psalm 121:7b-8, "He will watch over your life; *the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore."

Matthew 11:22, "But I tell you, it will be more bearable for Tyre and Sidon on the day of judgment than for you."

1 Corinthians 3:12-15a, "If any man builds on this foundation using gold, silver, costly stones, wood, hay or straw, ¹³ his work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each man's work. ¹⁴ If what he has built survives, he will receive his reward. ¹⁵ If it is burned up, he will **suffer loss**."

2 John 8 says, "Watch yourselves, **that you might not lose** what we have accomplished, but that you may receive a full reward." {NASV}

3. Let's build with urgency; because this life is like a mist.

James 4:14, "Why, you do not even know what will happen tomorrow. What is your life? You are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes."

Revelation 22:12, "Behold, I am coming soon! My reward is with me, and I will give to everyone according to what he has done."
