Text: Exodus 3:1-14

Big Idea: In spite of the struggles and inherent challenges, God gives us all the power we need to follow His call and purposes in our lives.

Exodus 3:1-2, “Now Moses was tending the flock of Jethro his father-in-law, the priest of Midian, and he led the flock to the far side of the desert and came to Horeb, the mountain of God. There the angel of the LORD appeared to him in flames of fire from within a bush. Moses saw that though the bush was on fire it did not burn up.

Exodus 3:3-4, So Moses thought, “I will go over and see this strange sight—why the bush does not burn up.” When the LORD saw that he had gone over to look, God called to him from within the bush, “Moses! Moses!” And Moses said, “Here I am.”

Transcendent & Immanent

Exodus 3:5, “Do not come any closer,” God said. “Take off your sandals, for the place where you are standing is holy ground.”

Exodus 3:6-8a, 9, “Then he said, “I am the God of your father, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob.” At this, Moses hid his face, because he was afraid to look at God. The LORD said, “I have indeed seen the misery of my people in Egypt. I have heard them crying out because of their slave drivers, and I am concerned about their suffering. So I have come down to rescue them . . .” “And now the cry of the Israelites has reached me, and I have seen the way the Egyptians are oppressing them.”

Exodus 3:10, “So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh to bring my people the Israelites out of Egypt.”

Ezekiel 22:30-31a, "I looked for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found none. 31 So I will pour out my wrath on them."

2 Chronicles 16:9a, "For the eyes of the LORD range throughout the earth to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to him."

Isaiah 52:7a, "How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news."

Exodus 3:11b, "Who am I, that I should go to Pharaoh and bring the Israelites out of Egypt?"

Exodus 3:12b, "I will be with you."

Exodus 4:11b, "Who gave man his mouth? Who makes him deaf or mute? Who gives him sight or makes him blind? Is it not I, the LORD?"

Exodus 3:13, "Moses said to God, "Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is his name?' Then what shall I tell them?"

Exodus 3:14, "God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you.'"

I. It will be sovereign work.

Exodus 3:10a, "So now, go. I am sending you."

II. It will be a saving work.

Exodus 3:8a, "So I have come down to rescue them from the hand of the Egyptians."

III. It is going to be serious work.

Exodus 3:10a, "So now, go. I am sending you to Pharaoh."

IV. It will be struggling work.

Exodus 4:21b, "I will harden his heart so that he will not let the people go."

Isaiah 6:9, "He said, "Go and tell this people: ""Be ever hearing, but never understanding; be ever seeing, but never perceiving.""

V. It will be a supernatural work.

Exodus 3:20, "So I will stretch out my hand and strike the Egyptians with all the wonders that I will perform among them. After that, he will let you go."
