Matthew 28:19, “Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.”

Romans 5:6, “You see, at just the right time, when we were still powerless, Christ died for the ungodly.”

Romans 5:8, “But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”

1 John 1:9, “If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.”

Romans 6:1a, “What shall we say, then? Shall we go on sinning?”

Romans 6:2, “By no means! We died to sin; how can we live in it any longer?”

Romans 6:2b, “We died to sin.”
