Texts: 2 Timothy 1:5, Deuteronomy 4:9, Genesis 48:8b-9, 15-16, Proverbs 17:6, Deuteronomy 6:1-2

Big Idea: Grandparents are in an ideal role to be positive catalysts for their family.

2 Timothy 3:14-15a, "But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures."

III. SEEK TO FINISH WELL IN THIS RACE CALLED LIFE.

Joshua 14:10-12a, "Now then, just as the LORD promised, he has kept me alive for forty-five years since the time he said this to Moses, while Israel moved about in the desert. So here I am today, eighty-five years old! I am still as strong today as the day Moses sent me out; I'm just as vigorous to go out to battle now as I was then. Now give me this hill country that the LORD promised me that day."
