Text: Genesis 1:26-28, Genesis 2:7, 15-25

Big Idea: When marriage is approached by a committed husband and wife, building on the right foundation, it can be the most fulfilling human relationship imaginable.



Psalm 127:1a, “Unless the Lord builds the house, its builders labor in vain.”

Matthew 7:24 Therefore everyone who hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on the rock.²⁵ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house; yet it did not fall, because it had its foundation on the rock.²⁶ But everyone who hears these words of mine and does not put them into practice is like a foolish man who built his house on sand.²⁷ The rain came down, the streams rose, and the winds blew and beat against that house, and it fell with a great crash.”

I. Separation: A Man Shall Leave His Father And Mother.

Genesis 2:24a, For this reason a man will leave his father and mother”

A. Our parents.

B. Our past.

II. Permanence: You Are To Cleave.

Genesis 2:24a, “For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife.”

III. Unity: They Will Become One Flesh.

Genesis 2:24, “For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh.”

IV. Intimacy: They Felt No Shame.

Genesis 2:25, The man and his wife were both naked, and they felt no shame.

Key question: are you drawing together or are you drifting apart?
