Big Idea: One's sense of vision grows out of their personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Text: Acts 26:19-23

Acts 26:19-23, "So then, King Agrippa, I was not disobedient to the vision from heaven. First to those in Damascus, then to those in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and to the Gentiles also, I preached that they should repent and turn to God and prove their repentance by their deeds. That is why the Jews seized me in the temple courts and tried to kill me. But I have had God's help to this very day, and so I stand here and testify to small and great alike. I am saying nothing beyond what the prophets and Moses said would happen—that the Christ would suffer and, as the first to rise from the dead, would proclaim light to his own people and to the Gentiles."

Psalms 138:1-2, "For this God is our God for ever and ever; he will be our guide even to the end."

Psalms 119:105, "I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you."

Psalms 119:105, "You guide me with your counsel."

Colossians 1:9, "For this reason, since the day we heard about you, we have not stopped praying for you and asking God to fill you with the knowledge of his will ..."

I. What Is God's Vision For You?

Psalms 37:4, "Delight yourself in the LORD and he will give you the desires of your heart."

A. It will draw you with energy more than drive you to exhaustion.

Colossians 1:29, "To this end I labor, struggling with all his energy, which so powerfully works in me."

B. It will be externally focused.

Matthew 16:25, "For whoever wants to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for me will find it."

1 Timothy 6:9-11a, "People who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge men into ruin and destruction. 10 For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people,

eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. But you, man of God, flee from all this.”

C. It will have eternal repercussions.

Matthew 6:19-20, Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. But store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal.

II. What Should You Do With God’s Vision For You?

Galatians 5:22-23a, “But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, 23 gentleness and self-control.”

A. You may need to let it incubate in your soul for a while.

B. When the timing is right, actively participate in God’s vision for you.
